Prior to the contract change the revenue was more or less \$15 million annually.

2009	13,531,849.15
2010	17,236,087.91

2010 is so high because there were 14 months' checks deposited, four of which were at the new \$1.25 million monthly rate. 2009 is low because there were only 11 months' checks deposited. The variance is just due to timing of deposits.
