

FIFTH AMENDMENT TO MASTER SERVICES AGREEMENT

This FIFTH AMENDMENT ("Fifth Amendment") is effective as of the last date signed by a party ("Fifth Amendment Effective Date") and amends and supplements that certain Master Services Agreement by and between Kankakee County Sheriff's Department ("you" or "Customer") and Securus Technologies, Inc. ("Provider", "we", or "Securus") dated January 27, 2011, as subsequently amended by that certain First Amendment dated February 3, 2012, Second Amendment dated May 10, 2012, Third Amendment dated October 8, 2012, and Fourth Amendment dated March 29, 2013 (the Master Services Agreement, First Amendment, Second Amendment, Third Amendment and Fourth Amendment collectively the "Agreement").

WHEREAS, Customer and Provider are parties to the Agreement and desire to amend the terms as stated herein:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Term.</u> This Fifth Amendment shall commence on the Fifth Amendment Effective Date and shall remain in effect through the Term of the Agreement. Further, the Term of the Agreement shall be extended by an additional twelve (12) months with a modified end date of January 27, 2018.
- 2. <u>Video Visitation Cable Installation Costs</u>. In connection with the deployment of the Video Visitation System as set forth in the Third Amendment to the Agreement, Provider agrees to pay for the cable company installation in an amount up to \$67,000.00; *provided*; *however*, that Customer agrees to pay for the monthly recurring bandwidth. Customer further agrees that during the Term of the Agreement, Customer will utilize best efforts to allow the full utilization of the Video Visitation System at the Facility in order to achieve a minimum of one (1) remote paid visit per inmate per month within the first six (6) months of its deployment, including without limitation:
 - a) Customer will allow Provider to market and promote the use of the Video Visitation System to the inmates, inperson visitors, phone call participants and potential friends and family end users of the System by allowing Provider to (a) distribute Securus' promotional literature in the Facility's visitation lobby; (b) add a recording to the IVR phone system promoting Securus Video Visitation Services to phone call participants; and (c) issue a joint press release regarding the execution of this agreement by both parties.
 - b) For non-professional visitors, Customer will eliminate all face to face visitation through glass or otherwise at the Facility and will utilize video visitation for all non-professional on-site visitors.
 - Customer will allow inmates to conduct remote visits without quantity limits other than for punishment for individual inmate misbehavior or other circumstances, which would justifiably prevent unlimited visits.
- 3. Except as expressly amended by this Fifth Amendment, all of the terms, conditions and provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.


