I listed below the rates that Evercom had and our current rates, which are a little lower in all categories. Regarding the pre-paid cards.......Since the collect local calls are \$2.00 for a 15 minute call, it may not make a lot of sense for the inmates to use a prepaid calling card for local calls because that rate is \$0.50 a minute with the calling cards. The calling cards were really to help cut the cost on long distance calls. We could setup a batch of local calling cards, where every \$2.00 would purchase a 15 minute call or \$0.13/minute. In this scenario, the inmate would get 37 minutes of local calling for each \$5.00 purchased. Right now, they are getting 12 minutes for \$5.00 purchased.
