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1 **<u>POLICY</u>**:

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It is the policy of the Mississippi Department of Corrections (MDOC) to establish and maintain
 an Inmate Welfare Fund.

8 <u>Inmate Welfare Fund (IWF)</u> – A fund established and maintained for the benefit and welfare of
 9 offenders.
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11 **PRECEPTS**:

Administration of Correctional Agencies (Central Office): Written agency policy governs the operation of any fund established for inmates/juveniles/residents. Any interest earned on monies other than operating funds accrues to the benefit of the inmate/juveniles/residents [2-CO-1B-14].

Adult Correctional Institutions: Written agency policy governs the operation of any fund
 established for inmates. Any interest earned on monies other than operating funds
 accrues to the benefit of the inmates [4-4044].

The responsibility for authorizing all expenditures and disbursements of funds from the Inmate
Welfare Fund will be delegated to the IWF Committee.
